Instructions for applying to Purdue Northwest

Type or print clearly all requested information.

- Application fee is \$25. Transfer students application fee is \$55.

- Missing or incorrect items will delay processing of your application.

To apply online, login to the PNW application at www.pnw.edu/apply-now
- You must be a graduate of an accredited secondary school and prove secondary school graduation by submitting official academic transcripts and graduation certificates. If you have attended an accredited institution of higher education, you need to submit all official transcripts. All documents that are not in English need to have true and attested English translations.
- You must meet the academic standards for admission set by the Purdue Northwest Academic Colleges.
- For admission into a degree seeking major, you must prove proficiency in the English Language by achieving one of the following, and submitting an official test score report or transcript:
 - TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score of 79 internet based (iBT), or 550 paper based test
 - IELTS (International English Language Testing System) minimum score of 6.5
 - A Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) verbal score of 480 or greater
 - British Ordinary Level English Language Exam (GCE/GCSE/IGCSE) Grade of A or B in First Language English
 - 12 transferable college level credits from an accredited US institution of higher education, including English Composition (must be equivalent to Purdue Northwest English 10400.) You must meet the minimum equivalent of a 2.0 on a 4.0 scale, some programs require a higher cumulative GPA, and/or specific course requirements.

If you meet academic requirements, but do not have English Proficiency, you may apply to our English Language Program. Our English Language Program (ELP) is an intensive English program that assists international students in developing their English Language proficiency to the level needed to pursue their education at Purdue University Northwest. TOEFL, or IELTS is not required for undergraduate admission upon completing Level 4 of ELP. ELP is a member of the University and College Intensive English Programs (UCIEP), English USA (formerly the American Association of Intensive English Programs), and is accredited by the Commission on English Language Program Accreditation (CEA).

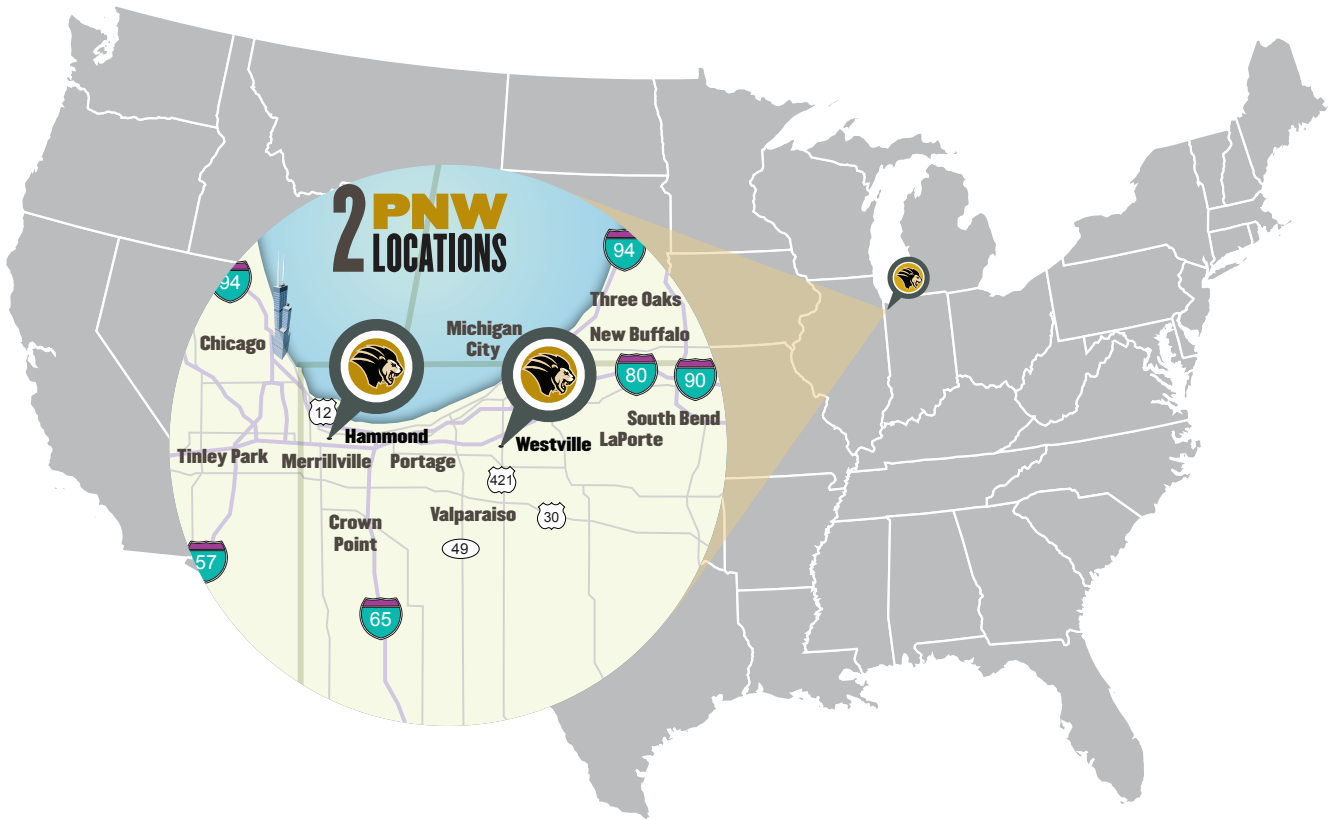
