Fees: £899 including academic activities, social events (welcome lunch and farewell dinner) and student accommodation (+breakfast) only.

Accommodation: Students will be allocated Archway Halls, the newest property opened for the first time in September 2021. You will be sharing a flat with eight study bedrooms, with a kitchen and open plan lounge/dining area. Each room has a large comfy bed, desk and chair, plenty of storage and en-suite toilet and shower.

Eligibility and Selection: The final decision will be made by your home institution.

Visas: If you need a visa to enter the UK, you'll need to apply for a Visitor visa to attend the summer school. [Check if you need a visa](#). Once you have an offer of a place on ISS2024, you can use your acceptance letter to apply for your visa. You should always check the immigration requirements for your country and your passport before departing for the UK.

Personal expenses: In addition, you will need to budget for living costs to cover food, travel and personal expenses. Manchester is a relatively affordable place to live in. It is cheaper to cook than eat out. A weekly grocery shopping is approximately £30-£60.

Insurance: All students are required to arrange their own travel and health insurance before arriving in Manchester.
